Elective Home Education (EHE)

Ofsted inspections now consider elective home education (EHE) as a key area when evaluating the experiences and progress of children. Inspectors expect local authorities to demonstrate clear oversight of children educated at home, ensuring their safety, welfare, and access to suitable education.

Where EHE processes are weak or poorly monitored, this can contribute to lower inspection outcomes—especially if children’s needs are not identified or addressed. Our EHE insight report enables local authorities to track trends, identify risks, and evidence strong oversight, helping to strengthen inspection readiness and, most importantly, improve outcomes for children educated outside of school.

Inspectors look for evidence of effective oversight, timely engagement with families, and proactive identification of any safeguarding concerns. Weaknesses in EHE oversight can lead to negative inspection outcomes, especially where there is limited visibility of a child’s learning or wellbeing.

Local authorities must be able to demonstrate:

- Accurate, up-to-date records of EHE cohorts
- Clear processes for assessing suitability of education
- Effective tracking of contact and interventions
- Escalation routes for safeguarding or non-engagement

Children Missing Education (CME)

Children missing education are at increased risk of harm and disengagement, and Ofsted closely examines how local authorities identify, track, and support these children. A lack of robust CME processes may result in serious concerns during inspection—particularly if it impacts a child’s right to education or safety.

Ofsted inspections analyse data on children missing education as a core area of focus, alongside children in care, care leavers, and those who are home-educated. Judgements are made using a four-point scale from outstanding to inadequate, with the overall effectiveness rating heavily influenced by how well children’s needs are being met, especially for those at risk of harm or disengagement from education.

A poor understanding of CME trends can contribute to severe findings and inadequate judgment. Our tailored CME report is designed to help local authorities proactively identify gaps, demonstrate apparent oversight, and support early intervention, helping ensure no child slips through the net and improving outcomes ahead of inspection.

Subject Access Request - Student History

Ofsted inspectors may request detailed case examples to understand how well a local authority tracks, supports, and safeguards individual children. - Evidence of follow-up, risk assessment, and re-engagement efforts
- Clear audit trails showing the authority's duty is being met
